Meet Brittney

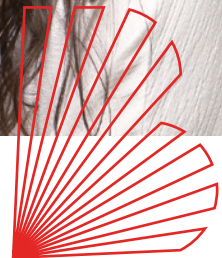

Meet Dayna

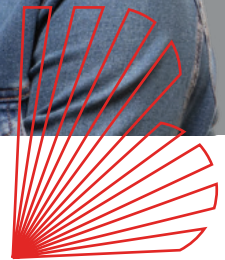

Meet Dione

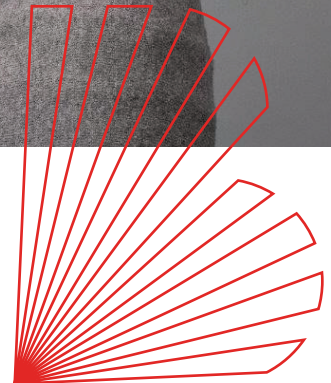
